RESOLUTION NO. R – 09 – 15 - 65

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A 36 MONTH MODIFIED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH CBTS (CINCINNATI BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY, LLC) FOR PHONE AND INTERNET SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$56,938.92

WHEREAS, Charter Section 8.02 (D) exempts from competitive bidding alterations and modifications in connection with any work or improvements covered by contract; and

WHEREAS, in April, 2013, the City entered into a 36 month service agreement with Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC (Cincinnati Bell) for the provision of phone and internet services; and

WHEREAS, the current 6mg bandwidth provided by Cincinnati Bell is not sufficient to adequately support the everyday phone and internet business needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, in order to better serve the everyday phone and internet business needs of the City, City Staff has recommended extension of the current service agreement with CBTS Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC (Cincinnati Bell) for an additional 36 months and to include upgrade of the current 6 mg bandwidth to 30 mg bandwidth and replacement of the copper lines at 6996 Taywood Road with fiber lines in order to increase speed and reliability.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:



That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a 36 month modified phone and internet service agreement with CBTS Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC (Cincinnati Bell) to include upgrade of the current 6 mg bandwidth to 30 mg bandwidth and replacement of the copper lines at 6996 Taywood Road with fiber lines.


