ORDINANCE NO. O - 02 - 16 - 03

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AMENDMENT OF CLAYTON CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 121.01

WHEREAS, Section 121.01 of the Clayton Codified Ordinances states, “The City Manager shall have the authority to make and enter into contracts, purchase equipment, supplies and materials, and authorize the performance of work and labor for the City of Clayton in amounts not more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000). When an expenditure, other than the compensation of persons employed by the City exceeds fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000), such expenditure shall first be authorized and directed by the ordinance or resolution of the City Council and in accordance with Charter provision, including Section 8.02.”; and

WHEREAS, in order to efficiently run the day to day operations of the City, it is recommended that the aforementioned \$15,000 City Manager authority as stated in CCO 121.01 be amended and increased to \$25,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That, Clayton Codified Ordinance Section 121.01 is hereby approved for amendment as follows (Additions in **bold** and deletions in ~~strikethrough~~):

121.01 AUTHORITY

The City Manager shall have the authority to make and enter into contracts, purchase equipment, supplies and materials, and authorize the performance of work and labor for the City of Clayton in amounts not more than ~~fifteen~~ **twenty-five** thousand dollars ~~(\$15,000)~~. **(\$25,000)**. When an expenditure, other than the compensation of persons employed by the City exceeds ~~fifteen~~ **twenty-five** thousand dollars ~~(\$15,000)~~ **(\$25,000)**, such expenditure shall first be authorized and directed by the ordinance or resolution of the City Council and in accordance with Charter provision, including Section 8.02.


2. That this Ordinance shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Ordinance or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.

3. That in accordance with Clayton Charter Section 4.031 the requirement that this enactment be read on two (2) separate days is complied with by readings on February 18, 2016 and March 3, 2016.

4. That in accordance with Clayton Charter Section 4.031(H) this enactment shall become effective thirty days after its second reading and enactment.


