A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO CLAYTON CHARTER SECTION 6.06(A) – OTHER DEPARTMENTS AND DIVISIONS

WHEREAS, the Clayton Charter Review Commission has submitted the following rationale for the below listed amendment to the Clayton City Charter:

Rationale: this is a modification which provides for more responsive and efficient operations and maintains consistency with the appointment of Department Directors.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the following amendment to the Clayton City Charter is hereby approved for submission to the voters of the City of Clayton at the November 8, 2016 General Election:

ARTICLE VI ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENTS AND DIRECTORS

6.06 Other Departments and Divisions

(A) Additional Departments, and Divisions or other Sub-units of departments, shall include those created by ordinance. Council shall consult with the City Manager with respect to creating additional departments, divisions or sub-units. Each Department shall be headed by a Director appointed by Council after recommendation from the City Manager, except Council shall appoint the Law Director.




