RESOLUTION NO. R – 06-17-28

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CLAYTON TO PURCHASE AND SHARE WITH SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES FOUR (4) WARNING SIRENS AND CONTROLS FOR A TOTAL COST TO THE CITY OF CLAYTON NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000.00

WHEREAS, protecting health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Clayton is a basic function of municipal government requiring full attention; and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County (as the Lead Agency) has been awarded a FY2015 State Homeland Security Grant Program Montgomery Terrorism Warning Sirens Project grant in the amount of \$246,000.00; and

WHEREAS, jurisdictions participating in the project have agreed to provide a 50% match for each siren purchased under this grant; and

WHEREAS, the winning bid of \$21,069.92 per siren (installed, complete with controls, backup batteries and pole) was accepted by Montgomery County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clayton has been allocated or sharing a total of four (4) warning sirens with the City of Clayton's share being \$10,534.96 per siren (which cost will be split with surrounding jurisdictions with respect to 3 of the 4 sirens) for a total cost to the City of Clayton not to exceed \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, bids were publicly advertised via the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program of which the City of Clayton and Montgomery County are members.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to contract with Montgomery County to provide or share four (4) warning sirens and controls consistent herewith and at a total cost to the City of Clayton not to exceed \$30,000.00.


