RESOLUTION NO. R - 07 - 17 -36

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REJECT THE BID OF STEVE R. RAUCH EXCAVATION AND DEMOLITION FOR DEMOLITION SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE 2017 CLAYTON CDBG DEMOLITION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO RE-SOLICIT BIDS FOR SAID PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Clayton City Manager has solicited bids for the 2017 Clayton CDBG Demolition Project for demolition services, said solicitation having been made in accordance with the provisions of Charter Section 8.02; and

WHEREAS, only one bid was received by the City of Clayton for said Project from Steve R. Rauch Excavation and Demolition; and

WHEREAS, the sole bid received by Steve R. Rauch Excavation and Demolition was for an amount substantially in excess of the budget for the said Project; and


WHEREAS, Charter Section 8.02(B) provides, "The City shall have the right to waive defects in a bid and to reject any and all bids and the Legal Notice published for said Project reserved the right of the City as follows: "The City of Clayton reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals....".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the one bid received from Steve R. Rauch Excavation and Demolition for demolition services associated with the 2017 Clayton CDBG Demolition Project is hereby rejected.
2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to immediately return any bid bond, certified check or other form of security submitted by the sole bidder, if any.
3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to assemble a bid package for the re-solicitation of bids for the 2017 Clayton CDBG Demolition Project for demolition services and advertise for bids at a later date.
