Position: Part-time Firefighter/Paramedic or EMT

Description:

The City of Clayton Fire Department is currently seeking part-time employees for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic or EMT. The position requires the successful candidate to be proficient in fire and emergency medical operations, hold and maintain all required certifications, possess excellent interpersonal skills, and perform other related duties as assigned. Hours could vary from 24/48, 24 hours every 6th day or fill-in (12-24 per week).

Wage Scale and Benefits:

- Firefighter/EMT- \$10.16 \$13.34 (depending on experience)
- Firefighter/EMT-P- \$13.34 \$14.76 (depending on experience)
- Firefighter/EMT-P (working as full time at another FD) \$14.76 *plus a Holiday Bonus up to \$2500* (depending on hours works and years of full time service)
- Employees working 24/48-hour schedule, health insurance will be offered after the first year.
- Paid time off given to employees who ride in charge at a station without an officer.
- Eligible to participate in process for career Firefighter/Paramedic positions.

Minimum Certifications and Licenses Required:

- State of Ohio EMT or Paramedic State of Ohio Level I or II Firefighter
- National Incident Management System (NIMS)
- 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- Valid State of Ohio Driver's License

Preferred:

- Hazardous Materials "Awareness and Operational Level"
- State of Ohio Fire Inspector

An oral interview panel and background check will be utilized in the selection process and the successful candidate(s) shall be required to complete a comprehensive physical and drug screening examination. All new hires are subject to a one-year probationary period.
