



Republic Service makes recycling from your home convenient with a single stream recycling process that eliminates any need to sort and allows you to place all of your recycling materials together in your toter.

#### RECYCLING MATERIALS ACCEPTED:

- Aluminum Cans, Trays & Foil
- Steel Cans & Tins
- Aseptic Packaging & Gable Top Containers (*milk & juice cartons*)
- Glass Bottles and Jars - (*clear, brown and green accepted, no window glass, dinnerware or ceramics*)
- PET Soda, Water, & Flavored Beverage Bottles (*#1 clear and green plastic resin*)
- HDPE Milk & Juice Jugs (*#2 clear plastic resin*)
- HDPE Detergent & Fabric Softener Containers (*#2 colored plastic resin*)
- PVC Narrow Neck Containers Only (*#3 plastic resin such as health & beauty aid products, household cleaners*)
- LDPE Grocery Containers (*#4 plastic resin such as margarine tubs, frozen desert cups, six and twelve pack rings*)
- PP Grocery Containers (*#5 plastic resin such as yogurt cups, and narrow neck syrup and ketchup bottles*)
- #7 Plastic Resin (*narrow neck containers only*)
- Plastic Buckets (such as a kittler litter container with a maximum size of five gallons and having no metal handles)
- Newspaper, including inserts (*remove plastic sleeves*)
- Cardboard (no waxed cardboard) all cardboard boxes must be broken down into 2'x2' pieces or smaller. Larger boxes, if not broken down, will not be recycled.
- Kraft (brown paper) Bags
- Magazines, Catalogs, and Telephone Books
- Office, Computer, Notebook & Gift Wrap Paper (no metal clips)
- Chipboard (cereal, cake & food mix boxes, shoe boxes)
- Junk Mail & Envelopes
- Paperback Books (no hard cover books)

#### Notes:

- All containers should be emptied and rinsed clean
- No plastic bags
- No motor oil, insecticide, herbicide, or hazardous chemical containers
- No plastic film, plastic sheets, or tarps
- No expandable foam or clear polystyrene
- No furnace filters
