RESOLUTION NO. R – 02 – 15 - 12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT PROPOSAL OF AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ADC CONCRETE, LLC FOR CONCRETE SERVICES RELATIVE TO UPGRADING SPECIFIED CURB RAMPS ALONG MAIN STREET TO MEET ADA COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, ODOT is scheduled to resurface S.R. 48 within the corporation limits of Clayton in 2015; and

WHEREAS, as part of the resurfacing project, Clayton is required to upgrade certain identified curb ramps along S.R. 48 to become ADA complaint; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited and received proposals from companies for the concrete services to upgrade the curb ramps, said solicitation having been made in accordance with the provisions of Charter Section 8.02; and

WHEREAS, the City received three proposals from companies and has reviewed same and determined that ADC Concrete, LLC submitted the lowest and best responsive bid submitted by a responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to engage ADC Concrete, LLC to provide the concrete services to upgrade the identified curb ramps as part of the aforementioned S.R. 48 resurfacing project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the proposal of and enter into an agreement with ADC Concrete, LLC for the provision of concrete services to upgrade the identified curb ramps to make them ADA compliant as part of the aforementioned ODOT S.R. 48 resurfacing project.
2. That this Resolution shall be effective as an exception to any ordinance, resolution or other legislation of the City of Clayton, Ohio, inconsistent with this Resolution or which imposes additional requirements for effectiveness or validity.
