A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE "MATRICULA CONSULAR" IDENTIFICATION CARD AS A FORM OF IDENTIFICATION IN CONDUCTING BUSINESS BETWEEN THE PUBLIC AND CITY GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, the County of Montgomery has a significant Hispanic population; and

WHEREAS, the government of Mexico issues its nationals who are living abroad a form of Consular identification known as "Matricula Consular" which is a personal identification card; and

WHEREAS, the Mexican Consulate requires proof of identity, nationality, and residential address prior to the issuance of the Matricula Consular; and

WHEREAS, the Matricula Consular identification card does not determine the immigration status nor does it confer any rights or privileges to the individual; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Department of Job and Family Services accepts the Matricula Consular for identification purposes only.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Council of the City of Clayton, Ohio supports the acceptance of the Matricular Consular as a form of identification in conducting business between the public and City government.


