## RESOLUTION NO. R - 11 -14 -72

### A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WRIGHT FLYER ICON TO BE LOCATED AT THE SOUTHWEST QUADRANT OF I-70 AND I-75

**WHEREAS**, Dayton is the hometown of Orville and Wilbur Wright, the “Wright Brothers”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wright Brothers designed, built and learned to fly the first powered aircraft in Dayton, Ohio; and

**WHEREAS**, though significant, the Wright Brothers airplane was only one of many inventions to come out of the Dayton, Ohio area; and

**WHEREAS**, the entire Dayton region, with its many colleges and universities, Wright Patterson Airforce Base, research, design and engineering facilities, continues to be on the cutting edge of technology; and

**WHEREAS**, the community desires to establish an Icon at the southwest quadrant of I-70 and I-75 to recognize the accomplishment of the Wright Brothers and depict the “Greater Dayton Area” as the “Birthplace of Aviation.”

### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the City of Clayton hereby supports the construction of a Wright Flyer Icon to recognize the accomplishment of the Wright Brothers and depict the “Greater Dayton Area” as the “Birthplace of Aviation”, such Icon to be located in the southwest quadrant of I-70 and I-75.
